MEMORANDIUM OF AGREEMENT

BETWEEN MANITOBA EDUCATION AND TRAINING (MANITOBA, CANADA) AND

SHANGHAI LUWAN DISTRICT EDUCATION BUREAU (CHINA)

In a spirit of mutual cooperation, and in order to enhance understanding and friendship between Canada and China, the Department of Education, Training and Youth(Manitoba, Canada) and the Shanghai Luwan District Education Bureau(China) agree to work collaboratively in the development and promotion of educational programs and opportunities between the two parties.

- 1) Both parties recognize that communication, and cooperation between Manitoba and China regarding educational matters will enhance mutual friendship and encourage the development of educational projects.
- 2) Both parties agree to discourse on comparable educational programs to assist with the development and promotion of educational projects.
- 3) Both parties are willing to offer opportunities for the cooperative exchange of teachers, training programs and visits between Manitoba and China.
- 4) Both parties are willing to offer opportunities for Cooperative exchange of students, students' summer camp activities and short-term visits.
- 5) Both parties agree to share curriculum teaching materials, teaching techniques and methodologies, and other related materials to promote communication and cooperation.
- 6) International Internet may be used in the process of this program.
- 7) Both parties are willing to promote school communication and cooperation between Manitoba and China.
- 8) Both parties support the academic research and specialized project study on education between Manitoba and China.
- 9) Both parties agree that all the communications and cooperation will be within the context of the laws and regulations governing Manitoba and China.
- 10) Memorandum of Understanding will be provided in both English and Chinese versions. Additional consultations will take place prior to the establishn1ent of a final agreement.
