

# NEW: Safe Foods for Canadians Regulations

**The new Safe Food for Canadians Regulations (SFCR) came into force on January 15, 2019. These regulations are a major step forward in safeguarding Canada's food system.**

Suzanne Lane, Senior Compliance Officer, Canadian Food Inspection Agency (CFIA) will provide you with information on the **New Safe Foods for Canadians Regulations** that food businesses will need to prepare for, such as:

- obtaining a licence from CFIA
- writing a preventative control plan
- meeting traceability requirements
- highlight which requirements apply and when to food businesses based on food commodity, type of activity and business size.
