

Youth Advisory Council

Application Form

Manitoba is creating a Youth Advisory Council (Council) to harness the forward-thinking perspective of young Manitobans on climate change and sustainable development issues. We are calling on Manitoba youth of all walks of life and from areas across province to help inform the implementation of the Made-in-Manitoba Climate and Green Plan.

The Council will consist of up to nine members who will serve on the Council for a one-year term starting in November/December 2019. Future terms for members of this committee will be considered over time.

Council members will:

- Be Manitoba residents;
- Ideally be between 15 and 25 years of age as of November 1, 2019;
- Represent the diversity of Manitoba and Manitobans;
- Be knowledgeable of issues related to the Climate and Green Plan;
- Demonstrate a proven engagement and interest in environmental issues and/or civil society issues;
- Engage in respectful, open discussion, and be accepting of differing viewpoints;
- Not be employed by the Manitoba government;
- Be willing to serve for a one-year term.

Members shall be paid reasonable travelling and other out-of-pocket expenses, not to exceed guidelines set out in the General Manual of Administration, which are incurred in discharging duties in connection with the Council.

The selection board will rely only on information provided in this application and applicant CV/Résumé to make their selections.

Applications are due no later than November 10, 2019 at midnight.

Step 1: Complete the pdf application form. You may fill it in online and save as a pdf or print it off, complete by hand, scan, and save as a pdf.

Step 2: If you are under 18 years of age (as of November 1, 2019), have your parent/guardian fill-in the permission form, scan and save as a pdf.

Step 3: Get your resume/CV ready (2-page maximum) and save as a pdf.
