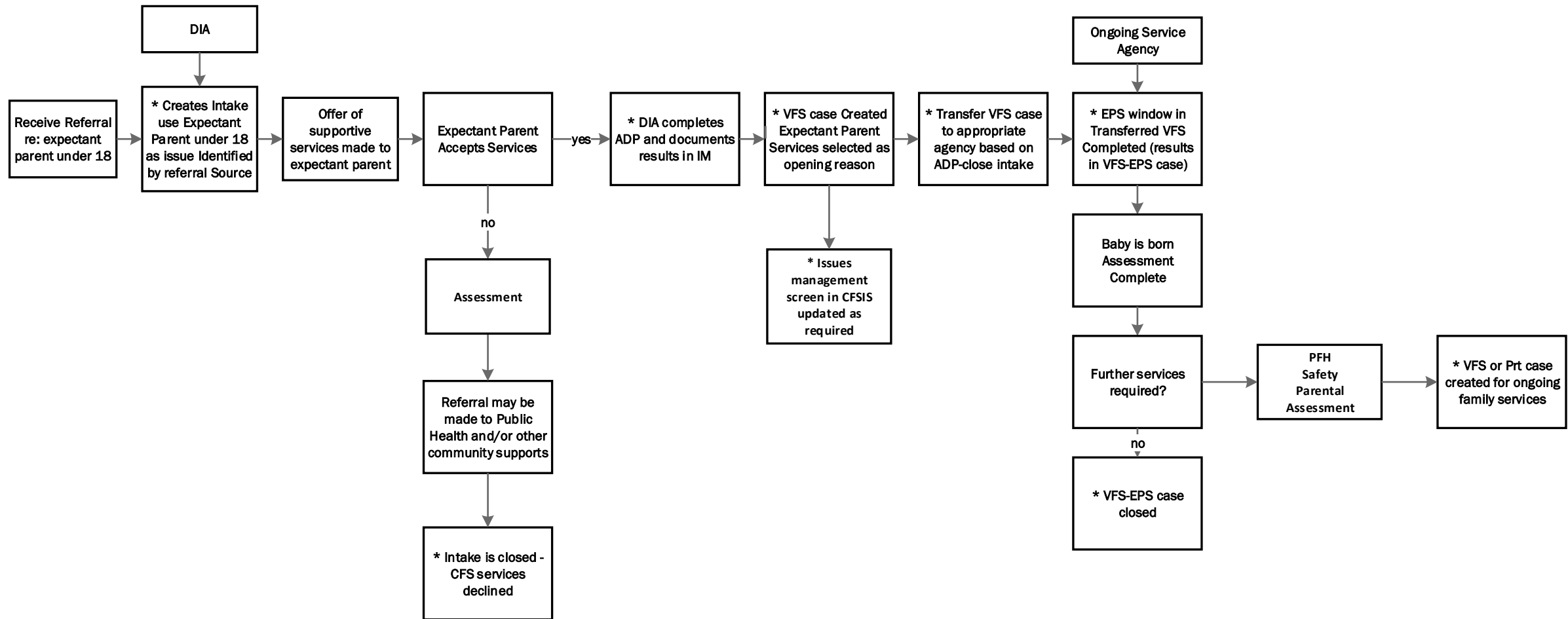
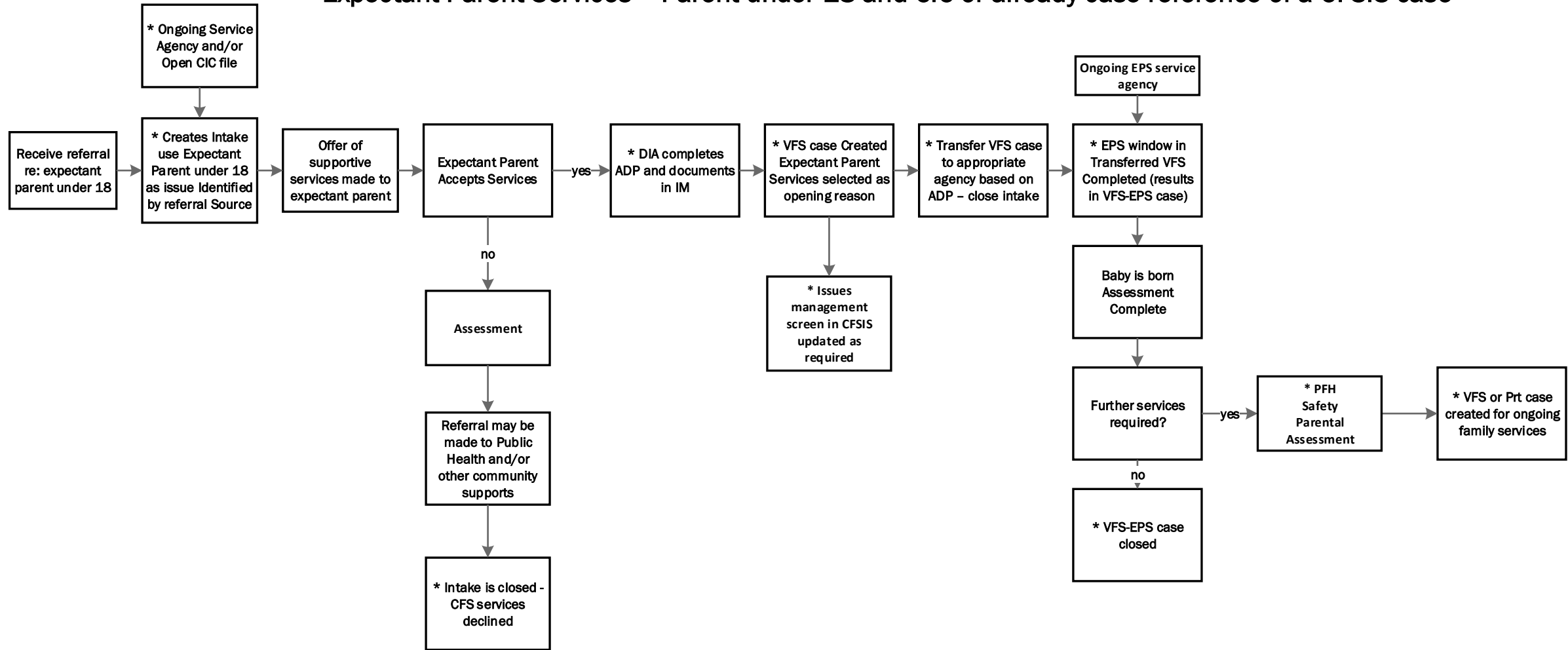


Expectant Parent Services – Parent under 18 No CFSIS cases



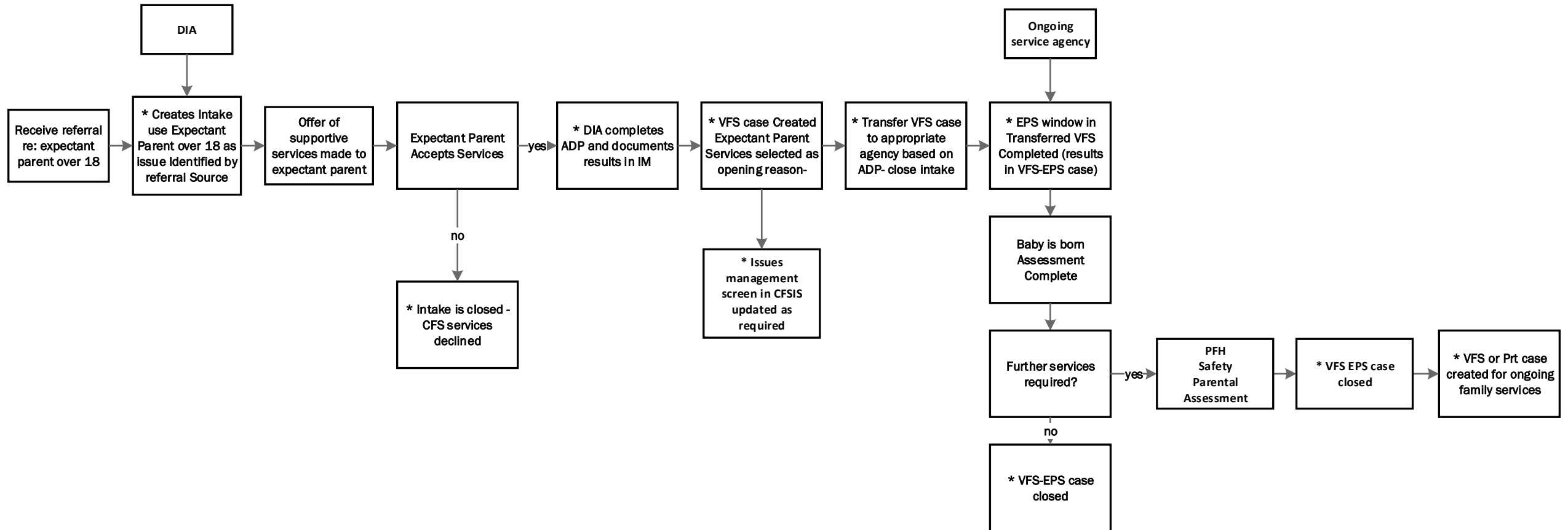
- “*” denotes where CFSA documentation should occur
- A new ADP is offered to first time Expectant parents under the age of 18 independent of what their parents chose for their family services
- Reason for opening the CFSIS case is always Expectant Parent Services in an VFS EPS case
- DIA creates the VFS case for the ongoing service agency and attaches intake to case

Expectant Parent Services – Parent under 18 and CIC or already case reference of a CFSIS case



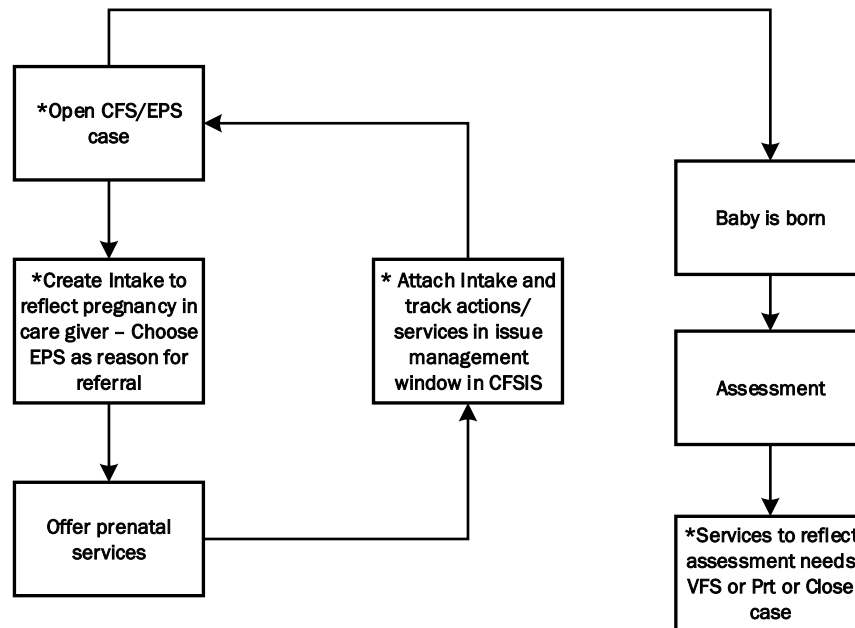
- “*” denotes where CFSA documentation should occur
- EPS information collected is not documented in the CIC or other open family service cases, but a new VFS case which will turn into a VFS-EPS case when the EPS window under details is completed in CFSIS

- Reason for opening the CFSIS case is always Expectant Parent Services in an VFS EPS case

Expectant Parent Services – Parent over 18 New referral



- “*” denotes where CFSA documentation should occur
- Reason for opening the CFSIS case is always Expectant Parent Services in an VFS EPS case
- the DIA creates the EPS case on behalf of the receiving agency therefore the intake will already be attached to the VFS case

Expectant Parent Services- Parent is Over 18 with Open CFS Case



- “*” denotes where CFSA documentation should occur
- An intake is created to document the expected pregnancy and is attached to the CFSIS case
- The issues management screen is updated to reflect services provided to the expectant parent
