



#### **COVID-19 DOSE DELIVERY SCHEDULE**







Projected for the next 30 days






Projections as of April 08. Each rise in doses represents a scheduled delivery.



#### DOSE ADMINISTRATION PROJECTION





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#### Where Manitoba's Doses Have Gone



#### HIGH-RANGE SCENARIO





# DISTRIBUTED CHANNEL MODEL

#### **Partnering with Clinics and Pharmacies**

- 54,600 doses of AstraZeneca arrived on Apr. 1
- Another 11,500 doses expected as early as today
- All vaccine received so far & necessary supplies have been shipped out to partners
- Vaccine allocations are 50 to 800 doses, with the average under 150

#### **Partnering with Clinics and Pharmacies**

- Updates on medical guidance was shared with partners, announced on Wednesday:
  - Aged 55-64 with prioritized health conditions
  - Aged 65+, no health condition requirements, priority for those who might not be able to access a supersite or popup (new)

 Online COVID-19 vaccine finder map will be adjusted as partners update us on their status (taking appointments or not)

### **SUPERSITE EXPANSION**

#### Winnipeg Supersite - Leila

- Manitoba's next supersite will be located at Winnipeg Soccer
   Federation Soccer North, 770
   Leila
- Maximum daily capacity of 4,154 doses

Expected to open May 7, based on vaccine supply




### VACCINE APPOINTMENTS

#### **Phone & Online Booking**

- To date, more than
   56,000 appointments made online
- Approx. 67% of appointments booked by phone

- Average time on hold: 2 mins
- Average time to make an appointment by phone: 8 minutes





#### VACCINE APPOINTMENTS

#### **Phone & Online Booking**

- 83,806 appointments currently booked at supersites and pop-up sites from today until May 1st
- Will continue to book up to 4 weeks out, based on confirmed vaccine deliveries

- This includes:
  - 60,087 Winnipeg supersite
  - 9,854 Brandon
  - 183 Thompson
  - 8,191 Selkirk
  - 2,035 Morden
  - 1,931 Pop-ups
