Preparing your unit for Ant Treatment

Manitoba Housing will be treating your unit for ants.

You must remain out of your unit for a minimum of 4 to 6 hours after treatment. It is recommended that persons with respiratory issues, pregnant women and newborns under 18 months of age remain out of the unit for 12 hours after treatment.

Prepare your unit as follows:

Kitchen:

- Remove all items including food, dishes, pans, and cookware from kitchen cabinets, drawers, countertops as well as the top of the fridge and stove and place on the top of the kitchen table or another table in the unit.
- Food inside the fridge and freezer does not need to be removed.

Living room, Dining room, bedrooms, bathroom, storage areas and basement:

- Pull all furniture and other items 2 feet away from the walls, leaving access to all baseboards.
- Remove all articles from closet floors and place on higher shelves. These items can also be
 placed on top of the kitchen table or another table in the unit and covered with a plastic sheet,
 towel or blanket.
- Clothes hanging in closets can remain.
- Cover fish bowls, tanks, and aquariums and unplug the filter.
- Remove all other pets from your unit and keep them out at least 12 hours after treatment.

After treatment instructions:

Do:

- Wash off kitchen counters, stove and fridge tops, and bathroom counter tops with soap and water.
- If mattress covers were installed during treatment, keep them on for the life of the mattress.

Don't:

Do not wash off cupboard shelves and drawers for 21 days after treatment.
