Based on the public health investigation, this exposure was assessed to be low risk overall for the community. Any individuals who attended are asked to self-monitor for symptoms.
The Pas	École Opasquia School (27-8th St., The Pas)	November 23, 2020 A confirmed case of COVID-19 was in the school on Nov. 23 when the individual may have been infectious. École Opasquia School is working closely with public health officials and following their recommendations. Based on the public health investigation, this exposure was assessed to be low risk overall for the school community. Close contacts of the case have been identified and advised to self-isolate (quarantine). The school will remain open to all other students and staff.

If symptoms develop, people should self-isolate and seek testing.</p>
