### **Winnipeg:**

The cost of a regular monthly bus pass for Winnipeg Transit will be increased from \$115.50 to \$119.35, effective January 1, 2026.

### **WINNpass:**

Participants who are eligible to receive a monthly bus pass amount, as part of an approved plan, should have the full rate added to their monthly budget. Staff should remind participants about the low-income WINNpass option, which offers a monthly bus pass at a reduced rate, if they are not eligible for monthly transportation costs as part of an approved plan.

### **Post-Secondary Passes:**

Participants attending a post-secondary institution may be eligible for a less expensive post-secondary bus pass. Staff should add funds to the participant's budget so that they can purchase their own pass from the institution.
