Naloxone is a medication that can temporarily reverse the effects of an opioid overdose or poisoning.

Take home naloxone kits are available for free to members of the public at risk for experiencing or witnessing an opioid toxicity.

The first and most important step in a suspected opioid overdose or poisoning is to **call 911**.








