REHABILITATION LEVY INCREASE FOR 2025

To ensure adequate financial support and accountability are in place for the annual Quarry Rehabilitation Program, the quarry rehabilitation levy will increase from \$0.12 per tonne to \$0.24 per tonne effective January 1, 2025. This will ensure the rehabilitation levy is generating sufficient funds that fulfill the program's rehabilitation needs. The rehabilitation levies become payable when quarry minerals are disturbed from their original position within a quarry mineral disposition.

Per section 134 of The Mines and Minerals Act the payment of royalty and the rehabilitation levy is required:

- For a casual quarry permit no later than the 30th day following the expiry.
- For a quarry lease no later than the 30th day following the anniversary date of the lease. The exception is with the renewal year; there is no 30-day grace period.
- For a registration certificate (private quarry) within 30 days of the expiry of the registration certificate

For exemption of royalties, see Informational Notice 2023 – 012.
