## **PPE Required:** Gloves, face shield, steel toe boots, eye wash bottle

## Steps:

- 1. No smoking or open flames. All electronic devices must be shut off (cell phones, radio phones) while near the refueling station.
- 2. Bring vehicle/equipment to pump.
- 3. Shut off engine.
- 4. Ensure you are using the proper type of fuel.
- 5. Unlock fuel tank, remove filler cap and fill fuel tank.
- 6. When finished filling, place fill hose back, replace fill cap on tank and lock fuel tanks.

## **Steps: Equipment**

- 1. Use CSA approved containers only, when using portable fuel containers to refill equipment. Ensure container is labeled to indicate contents.
- 2. No smoking or open flames. All electronic devices must be shut off (cell phones, radio phones) while near the refueling station.
- 3. Bring vehicle/equipment to pump. Shut off engine and ensure it is not hot enough to ignite the fuel.
- 4. Ensure you are using the proper type of fuel.
- 5. Unlock fuel tank, remove filler cap and fill fuel tank.
- 6. Either electrically bond or ground the containers when transferring flammable liquid from one container to another.
- 7. When finished filling, replace fill cap on equipment, replace fill cap on portable tank and store portable fuel tank in safe, secure and ventilated area.
