PPE Required: Steel-toe boots, hard hats, gloves (where situation requires)

General:

The physical task of snow removal must be evaluated as indicated in *Manual Lifting* (section III-F, SWP-1). Know your limits of the task, acquire assistance if required.

- 1. All work areas are kept clear of snow and ice accumulations.
- 2. Where an overhead accumulation of snow or ice creates a risk to a person over an entrance and sidewalks:
 - the accumulation must be removed; and
 - an overhead barrier designed to withstand any load that will be or is likely to be imposed is installed.
- 3. Follow the following procedures for snow and ice removal from roofs of buildings:
 - *Fall Protection* (section III-C, G-12);
 - Assembling & Using Scaffolds (section III-D, TSE-14); and
 - Using Portable Ladders (Section III-D, TSE-9).
