ELECTION OF SPEAKER FOR THE FIRST SESSION OF THE FORTY-SECOND LEGISLATURE September 30, 2019

- 1. His Honour, the Administrator, the Premier and Honorary Aides-de-camp meet in the Lieutenant Governor's reception room.
- 2. All **Members of the Legislative Assembly** proceed to their seats in the Chamber and **remain standing**.
- 3. At 10:00 a.m. the Sergeant-at-Arms followed by the Clerk, the Deputy Clerk and the Clerk Assistants enter the Chamber.
- 4. The Clerk tables the Roll of elected Members.
- 5. His Honour, the Administrator accompanied by the Honorary Aides-de-camp and the Premier enters the Chamber and takes his seat on the Throne.
- 6. The Attorney-General informs the House that His Honour, the Administrator is not prepared to present the Throne Speech until a Speaker has been elected.
- 7. His Honour, the Administrator will rise from the Throne to retire followed by the Honorary Aides-de-camp and the Premier. **ALL MEMBERS STANDING.**
- 8. The Election of Speaker is conducted by the Clerk of the Legislative Assembly.
- 9. The newly elected Speaker is escorted by the Premier and the Leader of the Official Opposition where he/she is invested with the robes of office. The Speaker returns thanks to the House.
- 10. His Honour, the Administrator, accompanied by the Honorary Aides-de-camp and the Premier enters the Chamber and takes his seat on the Throne.
- 11. The Speaker addresses His Honour, the Administrator.
- 12. The Attorney-General indicates to the House that His Honour, the Administrator will declare the causes of calling this Legislative Assembly on Monday, September 30 at 1:30 p.m.
- 13. His Honour, the Administrator will rise from the Throne to retire followed by the Honorary Aides-de-camp and the Premier. **ALL MEMBERS STANDING.**
- 14. The Speaker proceeds to the Throne and recesses the House until 1:30 p.m.

THRONE SPEECH PROCEDURE FOR THE FIRST SESSION OF THE FORTY-SECOND LEGISLATURE SEPTEMBER 30, 2019

- 1. His Honour, the Administrator, the Premier and the Honorary Aides-de-camp meet in the Lieutenant Governor's reception room.
- 2. All **Members of the Legislative Assembly** proceed to their seats in the Chamber and **remain standing**.
- 3. At 1:30 p.m. the Sergeant-at-Arms followed by the Speaker, the Clerk, the Deputy Clerk and the Clerk Assistants enter the Chamber.
- 4. His Honour, the Administrator accompanied by the Honorary Aides-de-camp and the Premier enters the Chamber and takes his seat on the Throne.
- 5. The Private Secretary delivers the Throne Speech to His Honour, the Administrator.
- 6. His Honour, the Administrator will say, "PLEASE BE SEATED" and then reads the Throne Speech.
- 7. After completion of the Throne Speech, His Honour, the Administrator will rise from the Throne to retire, accompanied by the Honorary Aides-de-camp and the Premier. **ALL MEMBERS STANDING**.

Prior to exiting the Chamber, "God Save the Queen" and "O Canada" will be sung.

- 8. The Speaker proceeds to the Throne and reads the Prayer.
- 9. The Premier moves:
 - "THAT Bill (No. 1) An Act respecting the Administration of Oaths of Office/Loi sur la prestation des serments d'entrée en fonction, be now read a First Time."
- 10. The Premier moves the appointment of a Chairperson of the Committees of the Whole House and Deputy Speaker.
- 11. The Premier moves the appointments of Deputy Chairpersons of the Committees of the Whole House.
- 12. The Premier moves:

"THAT the Speech of His Honour, the Administrator, be taken into consideration today."

- 13. A Government Private Member moves the motion for the Address in Reply to the Speech from the Throne.
- 14. The House adjourns.
