**Re: Environment and Climate Change, Parks Branch – Brereton Lake
Wastewater Treatment Lagoon – Environment Act Licence No. 1399 –
Notice of Alteration Approval**

Thank you for your notice of alteration dated March 23, 2026, and additional information submitted on March 31, 2026. The department understands you wish to repair localized berm erosion on the east side of the primary cell of the Brereton Lake wastewater treatment lagoon.

I approve the alteration per Section 14(2) of The Environment Act with the following conditions:

- Remove the rock that has been temporarily placed in the eroded area and dispose of it in accordance with all applicable federal, provincial, and municipal regulations and by-laws;
- Repair the eroded area using suitable clay material compacted to a hydraulic conductivity of 1×10^{-7} centimetres per second or less, such that a continuous clay liner with a minimum thickness of 1 metre is present beneath all interior cell surfaces of the lagoon;
- Complete the repair work no later than November 30, 2026, unless otherwise approved in writing by the director;
- Submit a report documenting the completed repair work within 30 days of completion.

All clauses of Environment Act Licence No. 1399 remain in effect. This approval is available on the public registry at <https://www.gov.mb.ca/sd/eal/registries/index.html>.
