**Declaration of Continued State of Local Emergency
Whiteshell Provincial Park**

WHEREAS: Out-of-control wildfires adjacent to and within Whiteshell Provincial Park is threatening infrastructure, properties and road and highway conditions within the area of the park in eastern Manitoba. Continued action to prevent harm or damage to the safety, health or welfare of persons located within Whiteshell Provincial Park, and to prevent damage to property within the park is required.

WHEREAS: These wildfire conditions present such an urgency within Whiteshell Provincial Park that this emergency requires continued action by me on behalf of Manitoba Parks

WHEREAS: The conditions warrant continued action by Manitoba Parks as the Local Authority to protect and safeguard human health and safety.

THEREFORE: Pursuant to subsection 11(2) of the Emergency Measures Act, Cap. E80 of the Continuing Consolidated Statutes of the Province of Manitoba, I, Rob Nedotiafko, Director of Parks, declares that the current state of local emergency for Whiteshell Provincial Park is now extended from June 6 to June 20, 2025, or until such time as this declaration is rescinded.
