LAURIE RIVER #2 GENERATING STATION – SHORT-TERM EXTENSION
LICENCE

We request a renewal of the Short-Term Extension Licence (STEL) for the Laurie River #2 Generating Station under the provisions of Section 92 of Water Power Regulation 25/88R. We request that the STEL be renewed for a five-year term. The fourth STEL was issued on September 23, 2025 for a one-year term ending September 30, 2026.

Manitoba Hydro continues to operate the Laurie River #2 Generating Station in compliance with the fourth STEL. The supporting documentation provided in 2010 prior to issuance of the STELs is still valid and ongoing compliance with the licence is documented in our Annual Water Levels and Flows Compliance Report.
