This letter acknowledges receipt of the report entitled “*2022 Groundwater Monitoring and Sampling Program at the Former Springhill Farms Industrial Wastewater Treatment Facility, Neepawa, Manitoba*” (the report) prepared by Stantec Consulting Ltd. dated December 2, 2022 for the above-noted property (the site).

Manitoba Environment, Climate and Parks concurs with the report and the results contained therein. The above noted report complies with the Remedial Plan for the site.

The department also acknowledges receipt of the Monitored Natural Attenuation Feasibility Assessment for the above noted property (the site) dated December 5, 2022 and prepared by Stantec Consulting Ltd.

This letter constitutes written authorization as specified under The Contaminated Sites Remediation Act, C.C.S.M, c. C205, s. 17.1 (1) for HyLife Foods to proceed with the remediation of the site as described in the Monitored Natural Attenuation Assessment. Any change to the Monitored Natural Attenuation Assessment must be approved by the undersigned prior to initiating the change.

The site remains designated as an impacted site pursuant to The Contaminated Sites Remediation Act, C.C.S.M, c. C205 and will remain on the impacted site registry until such time the contaminant is not at a level which may pose a threat to human health or safety or to the environment.

It should be noted that the position of Manitoba Environment, Climate and Parks as stated in this letter is based on the information provided to this office by Stantec Consulting Ltd. and relates only to the matters within the scope of the investigation that was conducted by Stantec Consulting Ltd. No additional site monitoring was performed by Manitoba Environment, Climate and Parks.
